BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL NOTE

The Baton Rouge Little Theater, originally called the Baton Rouge Civic Theater, was founded in 1946. The theater was one of many within the “little theater” movement that was popular in the early to mid-twentieth century. As of 2024, the Baton Rouge Little Theater has produced and staged over four hundred dramas, comedies, and musicals. In 2013 the organization was renamed Theatre Baton Rouge.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Baton Rouge Little Theater Records contain printed theater programs covering productions from 1975 to 2006 and organizational records concerning theater sponsors and advertisement placement in the production programs. The records also contain issues of *Spotlight: Newsletter of the Baton Rouge Little Theater* and actor headshots of cast members circa 1986. The records are arranged chronologically according to season.
