## SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Louisiana Labor Agreements Collection consists of 124 labor agreements published between 1947 and 1976. They primarily concern the sugar and meatpacking industries and are organized into three series: Meatpacking Trade, Sugar Trade, and Other Industries. Agreements are arranged alphabetically by locale ("Louisiana" for agreements covering multiple cities), then chronologically within each city.
